
## The Jesus Film Lent Groups 2018

It is claimed that the film Jesus is the most watched motion picture of all time with over 3 billion people having seen it. The film was released in 1979 and it has been dubbed into over 1.000 different languages.

The film is based, fairly faithfully, on the gospel of Luke and therefore makes a good addition to our current focus on this gospel at St James.
