Sunday Teaching

James - The New Testament letter of James (the brother of the Lord Jesus and leader of the early Church) is a fiercely practical book. Writing to believers James was concerned that they should not just say that they believed but live out their faith. They were saved by believing in the Lord Jesus and receiving the implanted word of God, but they were not just to be hearers of of the word, but doers, putting their faith into action. Many of the examples James gives of how we are to live out our faith are very challenging. Over this term in our Sunday morning sermons and home groups we will be working our way through the letter.

Numbers - At the evening services there is normally a short talk or reflection rather than a sermon. Towards the end of the term we will return to the Book of Numbers that shows us both the blessings of God and the sad failures of His people.

3 John - Early in the term at the evening services we will take a leisurely stroll through the third letter of John the Apostle. It is a personal letter written to a believer called Gaius but in its brief span covers a number of important matters of discipleship.

The Book of Love - when the people of Israel crossed over into the Promised Land their leader, Moses, was forbidden by God to go with them. As Moses prepared the people for what lay ahead he preached a (long) sermon and indeed sang them a song all of which is recorded in the book of **Deuteronomy**. Love is a recurring theme in the sermon and over our summer morning sermons we will be looking at the relevant verses under the title "The Book of Love".

Sunday and weekday activities

Our **I 0.30am service** attracts all sorts and sizes and families are particularly welcome. Most weeks the children have their own activities and teaching programme in small groups for part of the service. There is normally a Communion service once a month and occasional baptisms.

The **8.45am service** is quieter and usually a Communion service from the 1662 Book of Common Prayer, a service rich in Scripture and shaped by the glorious truth that we can be right with God only through faith in Christ.

The **6pm service** is also a quieter service but following different formats depending upon the week as shown on the programme.

There are a number of groups who meet together each week to read, discuss and learn from the Bible together. These are also opportunities for fellowship and prayer. Please ask if you would like to know more.

A parent and toddler group meets each Wednesday morning during term time.

Also on Wednesdays is a monthly communion service and a fortnightly Bible study group. Details are on a separate card.

Crew, for children aged 6-11, meets early on Friday evenings for games, activities and teaching. There are two different age groups meeting separately.

Rooted, for young people aged 11-16, meets on Sunday mornings and on Friday evenings at 8pm.

The Ladies Link meet once a month on a weekday evening for a range of activities.

A prayer meeting is held each Thursday morning, 9.30am in Church and this is followed on alternate weeks with a Drop-In for chat and fellowship over tea or coffee.
